# Introduction

Merchants must meet the following requirements in order to obtain PayPal® API credentials to feature PayPal on their Enterprise Payment Solutions™ (EPS) SmartPay Express™ website.

- Merchant must work directly with PayPal and establish a PayPal business account.
- Merchant must share API credentials in order to enable PayPal on their SmartPay Express website.
  - a. Merchant contacts PayPal to establish a business account.
  - b. Merchant accesses their business account at PayPal and obtains API credentials.
  - c. Merchant sends credentials to their FI in an email.

If a merchant already has a business account with PayPal, the process of sharing the API credentials is the same as described in this document.

## Requesting and/or Viewing API Credentials

1. Once you have established a business account with PayPal, log in to your PayPal business account: <https://www.paypal.com/>
2. Select **Profile | Profile and Settings** in the upper-right corner of the page.




FIGURE 1 - PROFILE OPTION IN PAYPAL

3. Select **My selling tools**.




FIGURE 2 - MY SELLING TOOLS OPTION UNDER PROFILE MENU

4. Select **Update** across from the **API Access** field.




FIGURE 3 - UPDATE OPTION TO ACCESS API

5. On the **API Access** page, options will differ based on whether you are establishing a new PayPal business account or using an existing PayPal business account with API access already established.

- New PayPal business account users: Select **Request API credentials** under the **Option 2** section.




FIGURE 4 - API ACCESS OPTIONS FOR NEW PAYPAL BUSINESS ACCOUNT USER

- Existing PayPal business account users: Select the **View API Signature** under the **Option 2** section.




FIGURE 5 - API ACCESS OPTION FOR EXISTING PAYPAL BUSINESS ACCOUNT USER

- Select the **Show** option for each of the **API Username**, **API Password**, and **Signature** fields.




FIGURE 6 - SHOW FIELD OPTIONS FOR API USERNAME, PASSWORD, AND SIGNATURE
